## Implementation Team

**Who** 6-10 team members, including administrator, an internal coach, data manager and representatives from each role

**What** Create the systems and processes to support program wide adoption

**How Long** \*Approx. 1.5 hours each month to meet

## Internal Coach

**Who** A member of the team who will be trained in Practice Based Coaching

**What** Observe visits, provide feedback and reflect on practices 2 times each month

**How Long** \*Approx 1.5-2 hours each month per coachee and

## Data Manager

**Who** Member of the program who can access the online data system to enter data and create reports

**What** Enter data online data system created by MNCoe, run reports, attend the implementation team meetings, and submit data to MNCoe 2/year

**How Long** \*Approx. 3 hours each month

## Coachee

**Who** Staff who are being coached, including early interventionists and related service providers

**What** Implement EQIP practices and participate in Practice Based coaching sessions

**How Long** \*Approx. 1-2 hours each month
